Pankow Basics

- Not the band!
- Population approx 410k
- 100km²
- Diverse/Stereotypes
- Expensive/Affordable
- Central/Suburban/Rural

GIS Basics


Grab some data with a GIS (QGIS and QuickOSM, ArcGIS Pro and OSMquery, ...)

Strip it down:

- No additional attributes, if not needed
- Fix geometries
- Clip if needed
- Single geojsons



Tippecanoe



Mapbox, awesome, easy

Full multicore support

Creates mbTiles, pbf

In our example:

tippecanoe -pk -pC -P -an -z16 -Z11 -e builds --extend-zooms-if-still-dropping

buildings.GeoJSON highways.GeoJSON leisure.GeoJSON --force*/

-pk: no size limit // -pC: no compression // zoom 11-16 // to folder "builds"

But why?

Smaller data size

Lower bandwidth consumption

Faster generation time

users zoom and pan throughout all scales

De-facto mobile standard

Easy customization

The map is rendering on the client's side and requires a bit more powerful hardware

Data is generalized and therefore not suitable for direct edits
